2017 Fundraising

THANK YOU for joining us on this journey of recovery, healing and hope! Our fundraising efforts in 2017, including a 5K in Franklin Park and a Gala at Venezia Boston, resulted in increased community engagement, an expanded supporter base, and a 23% revenue increase over 2016. 2017 Programs and Services

Shattuck Partners steps in where funding is limited to provide needed vocational, arts, recreational, and therapeutic support programs and services for patients of the Lemuel Shattuck Hospital. As an important public health hospital, the Shattuck is the "hospital of hope" for vulnerable women and men across the Commonwealth who seek recovery and healing from complex medical situations and difficult life circumstances. The programs we fund help these patients meet their treatment goals and develop new skills they can take back to the community.

In 2017, Shattuck Partners supported the following patient programs and services:



2017 Program Results

Vocational: Approximately 1300 vocational training hours were worked by patient associates in the hospital gift shop.

Arts and Recreational: There were more than 230 patient sign-ins to the monthly open mic program, more than 100 patient sign-ins to the two eight-week poetry and songwriting program cycles, and more than 350 patient sign-ins to the monthly Friday Flicks program, collectively representing more than 1300 hours of therapeutic and recreational time for these often long-term patients.

Therapeutic Support: Sensory modulation equipment and supplies to promote self-coping skills continued to be utilized on the mental health units up to 75 times per week. More than 2000 patient sign-ins were recorded for therapeutic groups on the public health units where supplies funded by Shattuck Partners were used. Reading glasses were provided to patients on the Department of Corrections inpatient units and emergency clothing was provided to patients on public health units. Treatment support continued to be provided for TB inpatients and outpatients including food vouchers for adequate nutrition, and transportation support to assist outpatients with essential follow-up care.

2018 Plan
